- Full-time enrolment is slightly above planned levels in first-entry programs (Arts & Science, Engineering & Applied Science, Commerce and Nursing) and second-entry professional programs (Medicine and Education).
- Enrolment at the Bader International Study Centre is approximately 75% of planned target and down by 19 students when compared to 2010.
- Full-time students in the School of Graduate Studies have increased when compared to November 1, 2010, however, are below planned 2011 targets by approximately 2%.
- The graduate programs in Business have increased by approximately 7% and specifically the Master of Management programs have increased by 200% compared to 2010-2011.
- Full-time enrolment has grown by ~3.6%, or more than 700 students, over 2010-2011. When combined with part-time enrolment in degree programs the head count has increased by 3.8%, or 810 students.
- Five-year full-time enrolment growth, from 2007-2008:
  - ~2,680 full-time students = 15%
    - Undergraduate +15% (~2115 students)
    - Graduate +15% (~565 students)
      - School of Graduate Studies +13% (~340 students); School of Business +35% (~200 students); Law +4% (19 students)
- International student enrolment remains at approximately 5% for undergraduate students and has increased to approximately 20% for graduate students.
- Countries with the highest representation:
  - Undergraduate: China, United States, United Kingdom, South Korea; France
  - Graduate (SGS, QSB, Law): United States, China, India, Iran, Saudi Arabia, Germany
