## Question from Senator Jones regarding Senator's email addresses on the web

A year ago, Queen's Senate approved a <u>SORC recommendation</u> "that Senators' names and email addresses be published and updated as required in a directory on the University Secretariat website," in order to "facilitate access by Senators to their colleagues." The minutes record that "The University Secretariat was instructed to publish email addresses in list form" (Minutes, <u>20 Jan. 2011</u>, p. 6). But to date, the Secretariat has still not produced the email addresses "in list form"; it has merely added links for individual email addresses to the <u>membership</u> page. As Chair of Senate, does Principal Woolf know why this multiple-address list has still not been published in accordance with a motion of a year ago, and will he now ensure that it be done to "facilitate access by Senators to their colleagues" and promote Senators' mutual discussion of Senate business?
