SUBJECT Hood approval for Masters in Public Health

I am writing to let you know that the Senate Committee on Academic Procedures considered and approved a hood design for the new Masters of Public Health program at its March 23, 2011 meeting.

The following was approved as the new hood for the Masters of Public Health program:

- black shell
- honeydew lining
- red border

The proposed hood design incorporates the honeydew lining found on the Masters of Public Administration hood, which also has a honeydew border, and the red border found on the Bachelor of Physical and Health Education and Bachelor of Kinesiology hoods. (The colour of "honeydew", when used in reference to Queen's academic hoods, is light green.)

With the design now approved, the Office of the University Registrar will undertake the necessary administrative steps in order to have the hoods available for Spring Convocation 2011.
