The Senate Creative Arts and Public Lectures Committee is reporting one addition and one change to the annual report submitted to Senate at the meeting of May 22, 2012 meeting.

- 1. The Department of Drama will be presenting "The Players Advice to Shakespeare" in place of the previously approved production "and Stockings for Ladies". This change has been made in accordance with criteria #5 of the terms of reference¹ for the George Taylor Richardson Memorial Fund.
- 2. The Brockington/Chancellor Dunning visitorship has also provided \$6,400 to fund the lecture by Dr. Stephanie Inglis entitled "The Mi'kmaq Nation and Cape Breton University: 25 Years of Success" nominated by Peter Thompson from the Department of Languages, Literatures and Cultures.
