

**Senate Committee on Academic Procedures**  
**Report to Senate**  
**Number and Type of Academic Integrity Cases Reviewed**  
**During the 2009/10 Academic Session (September 1, 2009 – August 31, 2010)**

In accordance with its mandate under s. 10 of the Senate Policy on Student Appeals, Rights and Discipline, the Senate Committee on Academic Procedures (SCAP) reviewed the procedural aspects of one recommendation for withdrawal from the University for a breach of academic integrity during the academic session of September 1, 2009 to August 30, 2010.

At its meeting on November 17, 2009, SCAP upheld the Faculty of Arts and Science's recommendation that an undergraduate student be required to withdraw for a minimum period of four years for academic dishonesty, and confirmed that appropriate procedures were followed.
