Report to Senate
Number and Type of Academic Dishonesty Cases Reviewed
During the Academic Session (September 1, 2007 to August 30, 2008)**

In accordance with its mandate under s. 10 of the Senate Policy on Student Appeals, Rights and Discipline, the Senate Committee on Academic Procedures (SCAP) reviewed the procedural aspects of one recommendation for withdrawal from the University for a breach of academic integrity during the academic session of September 1, 2007 to August 30, 2008.

At its meeting on January 30, 2008, SCAP upheld the Faculty of Arts and Science's recommendation that an undergraduate student be required to withdraw for a minimum period of five years for academic dishonesty.
