Report on Number of Non-Academic Discipline Cases Reviewed

In accordance with subs. 9(d) of the *Senate Policy on Student Appeals, Rights and Discipline*, if a student does not appeal a decision of the AMS or the SGPS Judicial Committee in which the sanction is a recommendation that a student be required to withdraw from the University, that sanction shall take effect only after it has been approved by the Senate Committee on Non-Academic Discipline (SONAD).

During the academic session September 1, 2011 to August 31, 2012, no such recommendation was submitted to SONAD for review and approval.
