The Department of Biology at Queen's University invites applications from suitably qualified candidates interested in co-teaching a course in Experiments in Plant Physiology (50% of BIOL 402*). This is an on-campus, elective laboratory course with an expected enrolment of fewer than 25 students. Candidates should have a M.Sc. or Ph.D, and teaching experience preferably at the University level in Biology. This is a winter term appointment for the period January 1, 2012 to April 30, 2012, with classes in session from January 9, 2012 to April 6, 2011.

The University invites applications from all qualified individuals. Queen's University is committed to employment equity and diversity in the workplace and welcomes applications from women, visible minorities, aboriginal people, persons with disabilities, and persons of any sexual orientation or gender identity. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.

Teaching Assistants and Teaching Fellows at Queen's University are governed by the *Collective Agreement* between the Public Service Alliance of Canada (PSAC) and the University. A candidate qualified to teach may be considered for appointment to a **Teaching Fellow** position as defined by the *Collective Agreement for Graduate Teaching Assistants and Teaching Fellows at Queen's University between PSAC and Queen's University*. Remuneration will be in accordance with the *Collective Agreement*, and appointments are subject to funding or enrolment criteria.
