THE WALLS TO BRIDGES EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM: BUILDING BRIDGES BEYOND PRISON WALLS

Walls to Bridges (W2B) is an innovative educational program that brings together incarcerated ("Inside") and non-incarcerated ("Outside") students to study post-secondary courses in jails and prisons across Canada.
