MES GRADUATE STUDENT RESEARCH SUPPORT AWARD -*APPLICATION FORM*

Supervisors of Full-time MES graduate students are eligible. A **limited amount** of funds are available from the School to help supervisors support MES thesis students who are pursuing interdisciplinary research **for which the supervisor does not have funding**. Supervisors are invited to submit requests for these awards by November 30 of the first year of the student's MES program. These will be reviewed by the Graduate Program Committee and responses should be available by the end of January. Supervisors who are anticipating applying for these funds are encouraged to inform the Graduate Assistant at the time of accepting the student.

The funds may be used to support the MES student's research activities including travel, fieldwork and analyses. Although the available resources vary from year to year, we anticipate awards will range from \$500 to \$2000.

Applications for funding should be submitted to the Graduate Assistant by November 30.
