COURSES

BEGINNER FRENCH

This course is designed to learn to conjugate basic French verbs (in the past, present, and future tenses), to study basic vocabulary and sentence structure, and to learn useful French expressions and cultural history. Through fun, stress-free, and educational grammar lessons, classroom activities, and regular homework assignments, students in this class will develop a strong base knowledge of the French language that will be a solid starting point for any further French studies. With a strong encouragement of student participation and classroom discussion, this course is designed to offer a positive and encouraging learning environment where students can improve their knowledge and application of the French language.

INTERMEDIATE FRENCH

This course is designed to learn general conjugation rules for all French verbs, to practice the nuances of different verb tenses, to study more advanced vocabulary and sentence structure, to practice expressing opinions, making comparisons, stating preferences, and presenting ideas in a clear and accurate manner, and to learn about interesting cultural figures. Through fun, stress-free, and educational grammar lessons, classroom activities, and regular homework assignments, students will strengthen their knowledge of the French language and culture. With a strong encouragement of student participation and classroom discussion, this course is designed to be a positive and encouraging learning environment where students can improve their knowledge and application of the French language.

ADVANCED FRENCH

This course is designed to practice French verbs, study advanced vocabulary and sentence structure, and practice translation, debating, giving presentations, analyzing literature, and critiquing French songs, films, or television shows. Through challenging, engaging, and educational grammar lessons, classroom activities, and regular homework assignments, students in this class will strengthen their knowledge of the French language and culture. With a strong encouragement of student participation and classroom discussion, this course is designed to be a positive and encouraging learning environment where students can improve their knowledge and application of the French language.

This course is easily adaptable to suit the needs of any group.
