Harris Mylonas joined the George Washington University in Fall 2009 as Assistant Professor of Political Science and International Affairs. For the 2008-09 and 2011-2012 academic years, he was the Academy Scholar at the Harvard Academy for International and Area Studies. Professor Mylonas' book, *The Politics of Nation-Building: Making Co-Nationals, Refugees, and Minorities* (Cambridge University Press, 2012), won *The Peter Katzenstein Book Prize* for the best first book in International Relations, Comparative Politics, or Political Economy in 2013. His recent publications include an article on China's policies toward ethnic groups forthcoming in *Security Studies* (with Enze Han), and an edited volume chapter on ethnic return migration policy and the right to freedom of movement in Greece.
