Biographical Note:

David Miller is Professor of Political Theory in the University of Oxford, and an Official Fellow of Nuffield College. His books include *On Nationality* (Oxford: Clarendon Press, 1995), *Principles of Social Justice* (Cambridge, Mass.: Harvard University Press, 1999), and *National Responsibility and Global Justice* (Oxford: Oxford University Press, 2007). A collection of his recent papers on aspects of justice has just been published by Cambridge University Press under the title *Justice for Earthlings: Essays in Political Philosophy*. He is continuing to work on questions of social and global justice, as well as on the issue of boundaries in democratic theory, and on immigration.
