Job Requirements and Term of Employment:

- Teaching Assistants will receive training and preparation prior to the start of the course.
- The teaching assistants that we are seeking are for the support of online courses.
- Some training and preparation are needed before the start of the course.
- Candidates must be flexible in terms of availability during online office hours.
- Candidates must be willing to provide students with timely and constructive feedback in OnQ.
- Must have access to the internet and a computer that meets minimum requirements.
- Experience with learning management systems (eg onQ) and videoconferencing software (e.g. Zoom or Adobe Connect) would be an asset.
- The contract period runs from May 1, 2024 to July 31, 2024.

Term Dates:

May 1 – August 31, 2024 Courses in session from May 6, 2024 – July 26, 2024

Contract Hours and Rate of Pay:

Positions will be offered only if course enrolment allows.

ASO anticipates that TAships in PSYC 100 will require a commitment of 130 hours, and TAships for PSYC 251 and PSYC 397 will require a commitment of about 70 hours each. These commitments may change depending on enrolment in the courses and departmental resources available to supplement support to the class. The number of hours of work will be determined by actual enrolment numbers close to the start of term.

The rate of pay for Teaching Assistants is commensurate with the rates specified in the collective agreements of Teaching Assistants (PSAC).

The Psychology Coordinator of Graduate Studies will make all final decisions, in line with the <u>PSAC 901 Agreement</u> and priorities TA position offers will follow via email from the Department of Psychology Graduate Program Administrator.
