November 2008 Enrolment Report  
Executive Summary**

The annual report on enrolment is based on the actual number of students, or head count, consistent with the approved enrolment plan. Attached are several summary tables that include current and historical data reported according to full-time and part-time and international versus domestic status, by program and year of study. More detailed enrolment count reports are filed each November, February, May, and June with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.

The report and supporting tables highlight that actual enrolment meets or exceeds enrolment targets and projections in almost every Faculty and School. The enrolment plan, approved by Senate in March 2008, projected modest growth at the undergraduate level combined with continuing expansion of masters and doctoral enrolment. At November 1, 2008, total full-time enrolment is almost 800 students more than 2007, representing a net increase in undergraduate and professional enrolment of approximately 665 students (a 5% increase), with increases in graduate enrolment in the School of Graduate Studies and Research (+91) and the School of Business (+40).

The **total full-time enrolment of 17,367** is relative to a planned range of 17,161 – 17,349. The overall enrolment at the University on November 1, 2008, including all part-time, Theological College, and Post-Graduate Medical students, was **21,468**, compared to a total of 20,515 in 2007.

***Highlights:***

- The largest undergraduate entering class in Queen's history (3,692) came from every Canadian province with an impressive 7.3% from outside of Canada (including Canadian citizens and foreign nationals). The average entering grade was 87.3% with presented marks ranging upward from 80%; students are admitted on the basis of academic performance and supplementary information (e.g., personal statements of experience, auditions, portfolio reviews) and those students with the strongest overall qualifications are selected for offers of admission.
- A combination of higher first year intake targets, increased demand for science and engineering, and a less conservative approach to managing offers of admission, resulted in an increase in the conversion ratio for students accepting our offers of admission, particularly in Arts, Engineering, and Commerce. The gender balance in these programs is entirely consistent with past experience.
- A diverse enrolment of full-time students, across all years in all direct-entry undergraduate and second-entry professional programs, represent every Canadian province and territory, with 36.68% originally from the Greater Toronto Area, more than 40% from Ontario outside the GTA (including 6.5% from Kingston), 2.5% from the United States, and a further 4.99% from 82 other international countries.
- Enrolment in professional programs (Law and Medicine) is on target with planned enrolment and past experience (approximately 865 full-time students) while Education faced challenges meeting the planned target with a softening of demand experienced across the Province. Total 2008 professional enrolment is 1522 versus 1551 in 2007.
- Enrolment in the School of Graduate Studies and Research meets the projection for the total number of Doctoral students but falls short of planned growth in Masters' programs, according to the Senate plan as well as the projected growth in domestic eligible students as defined and reported to the MTCU for graduate expansion funding.

Continued attention will be focused on graduate student expansion plans and projections to meet overall enrolment goals and objectives.
