2. Engineering and Applied Science Students are assessed on a per unit basis up to 16.1 units per term. The maximum per term tuition is equal to 1/2 of the tuition fee.

Registration in the Engineering & Applied Science Extended (900 section) program rewrites (Summer Term 2016) incurs a fee of \$466.00 per rewrite. Supplemental examination incurs a fee of \$250.00 per exam (see Faculty calendar for details).

6. Registration in PACT 338 or 438 incurs an additional fee of \$400.00 per course.
