

**Senate Committee on Non-Academic Discipline**  
Report to the Senate

Queen's University Draft Student Code of Conduct  
September 20, 2007

Queen's University Senate approved a motion at the April 26, 2007 meeting to refer the Draft Student Code of Conduct to all relevant constituencies for review and comment. Currently the deadline for submission of comments regarding the Draft Student Code of Conduct is set for October 1, 2007.

Student Senators have requested an extension to the deadline for comments in order to hold a town hall meeting on October 15, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. at the Lower Ceilidh, John Deutsch University Centre. Senate is seeking broad consultation with the University community in order to refine the draft document to create a Student Code of Conduct that sets the standards for student responsibility and behaviour. With this in mind, and to ensure that every opportunity for input is realized, the **new deadline for all submissions is October 19, 2007.**

Submissions will be reviewed and summarized by a SONAD sub-committee and then reported to Senate to form the basis for discussion during an informal session scheduled for the November 15, 2007 Senate meeting. Depending on the number of comments, the nature of the discussion, and the convergence of opinion, SONAD will revise the Draft Student Code for submission to Senate for approval at the February 28, 2008 Senate meeting.

Greater collaboration will improve the quality of the final product.
