

Science 1948 ½ Mature Student Entrance Bursary Application

Deadline: February 15, 2018



Eligibility

This award was established to assist mature students demonstrating financial need that did not have the opportunity to pursue a post-secondary degree. Applicants with prior post-secondary degrees are not eligible.

Mature students* who have applied for admission to the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science at Queen's University who demonstrate financial need.

****A mature student is someone who has been out of the traditional system of education for at least three years.***

Criteria for Selection

- Demonstrated financial need.

- Applicants should be planning to enter Queen's as a full-time student in the first year of an undergraduate degree program in the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science in September 2018.

- Applicants must be Canadian citizens.

- Applicants must meet the admission requirements for application to the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science and demonstrate the potential for academic success to the Dean of Applied Science.

Exceptions may be considered for students with some university transfer credits.

Value

\$76,000 over 4 years, provided a minimum GPA of 2.0 is maintained and financial need remains evident.

Distribution of award: four annual installments of \$19,000.

Deadline

Completed applications must be received by the Student Awards Office by February 15, 2018.

In order to be eligible for the Science 1948 ½ Mature Student Entrance Bursary you must meet the admission requirements for the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science and demonstrate the potential for academic success. In order to evaluate the academic component for candidates that have applied for the Science 1948 ½ Mature Student Entrance Bursary, you must submit any outstanding documents to Undergraduate Admission and Recruitment by April 1, 2018. If you are unable to provide official transcripts by this date then we will accept unofficial transcripts in the interim.
