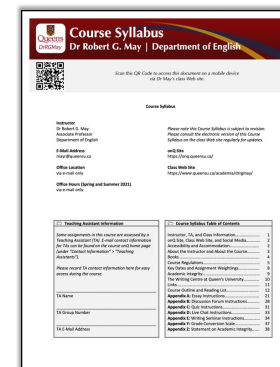
Name Card

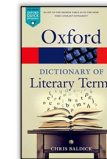
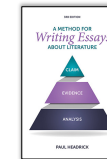

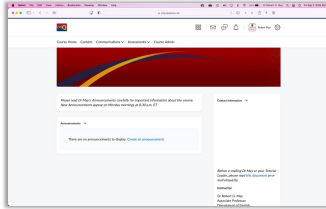
