Paper Type


We print on Matte Coated Paper 170gsm only

Dimensions

Due to the limited size of our poster printer we are only able to print up to a maximum width of 36" (3ft or 91cm). There is no limitation on the length of a poster (within reason). A standard size poster is 36" x 48" (3ft x 4ft or 91cm x 122 cm).

Posters can be printed in either portrait or landscape. Our poster paper is 36 inches wide so one side of your poster must be 36 inches or smaller (if smaller, there will be a white border that we do not cut down).



Format

We accept PDF or PowerPoint files only (ideally send both). Please ensure that the file is formatted to the correct dimensions of your poster with a width of no larger than 36". *There have been known issues with certain types of graphics not printing correctly*. Please print a small proof to ensure that your graphics will print.

Note: Posters are printed as-is so please ensure that there are no errors or omissions in the file provided before emailing it.
