## Admissions Requirements & Application

Selection of teacher candidates is based on the application requirements in TEAS Requirements for Queen's (<https://www.ouac.on.ca/guide/teas-queens/>) as well as the supplemental documents submitted to Education Student Services.

Applicants admitted without an undergraduate degree must be of Indigenous ancestry and submit documentary proof of their ancestry as specified by the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT) when they apply for certification. It is the candidate's responsibility to check the OCT website (<https://www.oct.ca/home.aspx?lang=en>) or contact the College (1-888-534-2222) in advance to determine what documentation is required.
