Appeal to the Associate Dean (Academic)

You may appeal the finding of departure from academic integrity and/or the sanction imposed as a result of an instructor's finding to the Associate Dean (Academic). You have 21 calendar days after receiving the Notification of the Finding of a Departure from Academic Integrity to submit a written appeal and copies of the relevant documents. Normally, the Associate Dean (Academic) will meet with you (and your representative, if applicable), the instructor (and his or her representative), and witnesses where appropriate to conduct a thorough investigation of the evidence. See Academic Regulation 1, and Appeal Regulations Section 2 (Appeals Related to Academic Integrity) of the Arts and Science Calendar.
