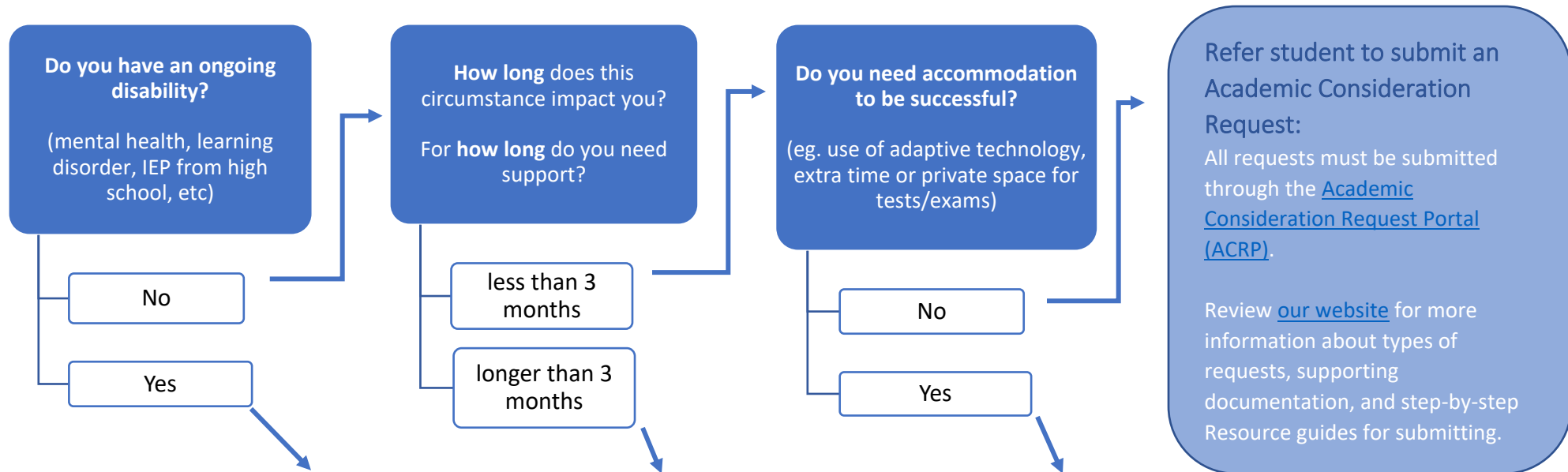


Academic Consideration VS Accommodation

[Academic Consideration](#) is provided for students who are experiencing unforeseeable extenuating circumstances that impact their ability to complete their academics for a period of 3 days – 3 months. Academic Consideration is a compassionate response governed by [Queen’s Academic Consideration for Student in Extenuating Circumstances Policy](#).

[Academic Accommodation](#) is provided to equalize learning opportunities for students with functional limitations from visible and non-visible disabilities. Academic Accommodation is a right to equal opportunity protected by the Ontario Human Rights code. Accommodations are provided by [Queen’s Student Accessibility Services \(QSAS\)](#).

To help understand if a student’s situation warrants [Consideration or Accommodation](#), ask the following questions:



Refer student to Queen’s Accessibility Services (QSAS):
