

COURSE MAPPING WORKSHEET

This worksheet will help you set up a detailed road map for your courses so you can stay on track to meet your degree requirements.

Be sure to verify the Core, Option, Supporting and Additional courses required for your Plan(s) – Specialization, Major, Medial, Minor, General – or your Certificate.

The Undergraduate Chair & Assistant in each [Department](#) can give you specific advice about the courses and pathway for your Plan requirements.

Once you've mapped out your Plan requirements, you can add the elective courses for your Program. Students sometimes forget that their degree is made up of the Plan requirements AND the electives!
