

FAQs about Your Application and the Fee Reimbursement

Can I apply next year instead and still have my fee covered?

This is a pilot project for this year. We may continue this in future years but at this time that is unknown. Please stay tuned to our website or get in touch next fall to let us know your interest.

How will be reimbursement be sent to me?

Your reimbursement cheque will be sent to the department(s) you applied to for pick up. You'll receive an email before hand to let you know that it is ready. It will take approximately 4-8 weeks for processing, a little longer during the holidays.

Can I apply to a program outside of the Faculty Arts and Science?

You can certainly apply to other programs outside of Arts and Science, however, the fee reimbursement is only available for applications to Arts and Science programs.

What if I change my mind about Grad School after I apply?

That's ok. Once we've received your completed application you will receive the fee reimbursement regardless of if you come to Queen's in the end. Of course, we do want you to choose us and choose Grad School, but understand that sometimes life gets in the way.

Do I still have to submit my transcripts?

Your Queen's transcripts will be submitted automatically so you don't need to submit it. If you have transcripts from other institutions you will need to include those in your application.

What if my GPA changes between now and May?

We hope that it doesn't, and we have confidence in you, however if your GPA does drop below the A- standing, we will still honour this fee reimbursement offer. If you received this email you are on the list so you don't need to worry. Do keep studying though - finish with a bang!

Do I have to have my research idea fully fleshed out?

Not yet. For some programs you will want to submit some research ideas and interests but other programs don't need you to have any idea where you want to go with your studies. Work with your grad coordinators to help you define what you need to apply.

Do I need to have a supervisor already chosen?

No and yes. It's a good idea to have some in mind and to reach out to those supervisors ahead of time to see if they are interested in working with you. These supervisors can help push your application along. If you're not sure who to reach out to, the grad coordinators can help you with that.

Are professional Master's programs eligible?

Yes. All Master's programs are eligible for this offer.

Are graduate diploma programs eligible?

No, unfortunately, the fee reimbursement is only available for Master's and PhD programs.

Is this open to all students at Queen's?

This is open to all students with a current cumulative GPA of A- or above that will be graduating Fall 2017 or Spring 2018 from an honours program.



Is this open to students outside of Queen's?

No, not at this time.

What if I've already submitted my application?

That's great! You're on the list and we'll be in touch soon about your reimbursement.
