The Alexander and Ian Vorres Hellenic Travel Bursary Application

The Alexander and Ian Vorres Hellenic Travel Fellowship was established by Mr. Ian Vorres, B.A. '50. The fellowship will be awarded to a graduate student or an upper-year undergraduate student, on the basis of academic achievement and a written proposal. Selection will be made by the Department of Classics Awards Committee.

Award winners should note that the award will first be applied to the student's fee account, should there be any outstanding fees. The full amount of the award (or the balance after outstanding fees are paid) will be forwarded to the recipient in a cheque or deposited into the student's online-listed bank account.

Eligibility - Please circle the option for which you are applying

Eligibility includes (listed in order of priority).

1. Ontario Resident
2. To pursue original work (a thesis or other project) in Greece on a subject related to Greece of any historical period, in philology, archaeology, history, or philosophy.
3. To participate in a summer session or excavation in Greece sponsored by the Canadian Archaeological Institute in Athens, The American School of Classical Studies in Athens, or other approved institutions.
4. To attend a program at The American School of Classical Studies in Athens, The College Year in Athens, or other approved institution.
5. Attending the Vorres Museum in Athens.

If you receive any of these funds, you **will be required to present** your paper and your experience at our annual Travel Awards Conference.
