

CLST 131: Introduction to Archaeology II: Methods and Analysis (Fall 2020)

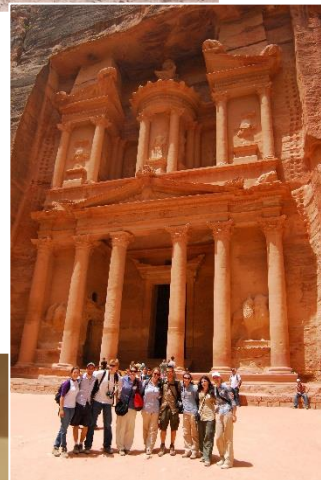
How should we approach the material remains of past cultures in the 21st century?
