The Online Advantage

Online learning offers a flexible approach to complete a degree while balancing your busy work and personal life.

- Courses are designed to fit your lifestyle with course materials being available 24/7 through our online platform.
- Course content is paired with live webinars, discussion forums, and individual conversations with professors to create an interactive learning environment.
- Assessments include individual and team projects, live negotiation activities, town hall debates, presentations, quizzes, and exams; all of which can be completed from your home.



The In-Person Sessions

There are currently two residential sessions.

- The first session is held at the start of the program (September) over 5 days at Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario. Get to know your professors and students before starting online courses and take leadership workshops.
- The second session is held mid-way through the program (summer) over 8 days in Calgary, Alberta. Complete one of your core courses in just a week.
- There is an optional 8-day field trip course where students visit sites in Western Canada.
