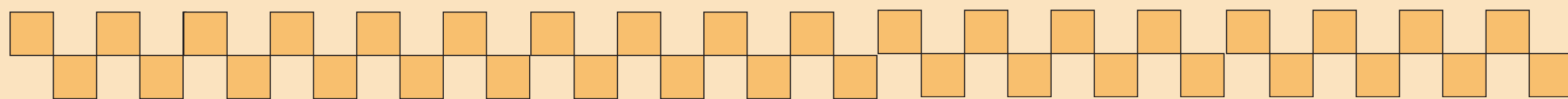

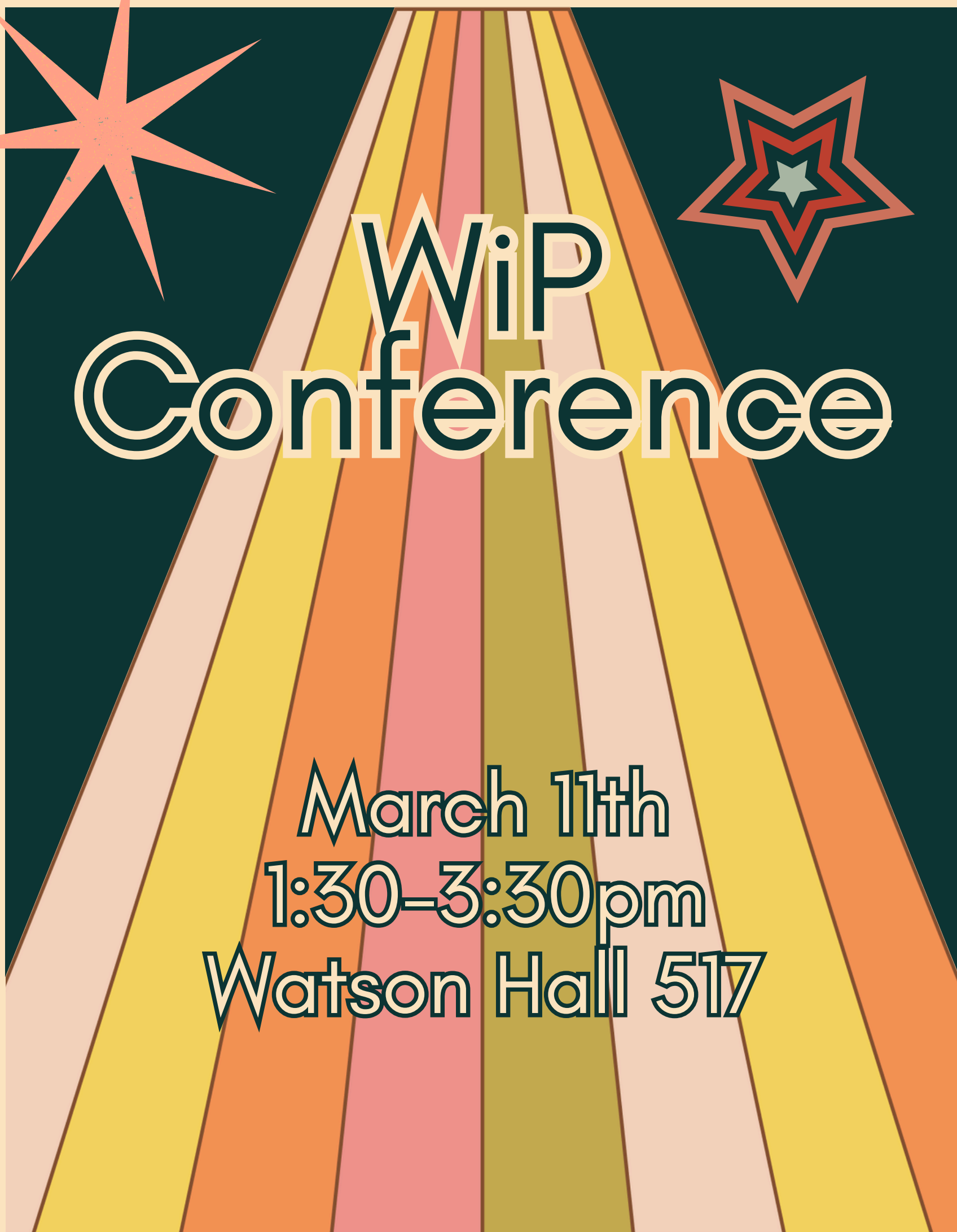

- a term or conference paper in early stages
