Attachment "A" provides the distribution of July 2025 merit scores for all Tenure/Tenure-track faculty in the QUFA bargaining unit. Please note, as per the Queen's-QUFA 2025-2026 Collective Agreement Articles 42.2.2.7 and 42.2.2.8, additional merit points were added to the academic merit pool.


Attachment "B" provides the distribution of July 2025 merit scores, for all Tenure-track faculty in the QUFA bargaining unit, by rank and Faculty/School.

Attachment "C" graphs the July 2025 nominal academic salaries for all Tenure/Tenure-track faculty in the QUFA bargaining unit by 5-year experience groups. Please note the box-plots are intended to reflect the general relationship between academic experience and salary. The wide distribution of salaries in any given experience grouping is the product of many factors, including academic achievement and market factors, and should be considered when reviewing these statistics. In the case of individuals with administrative stipends, only the nominal academic salary is included in this data.

Attachments "D" (see web hyperlinks provided) graph the July 2025 nominal academic salaries for QUFA Tenure/Tenure-track faculty within discipline groups and 5-year experience groups.
