INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

Students who are NOT registered in a French Studies Plan but have taken certain French courses at Queen's, or received equivalent transfer credit, are eligible for a Certificate of Competence in French Language.

NOTE: this is not a Senate-approved Certificate Program and therefore **will be noted as an Academic Milestone on the transcript.**

REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ **18.0 units in French**, including required courses:
- ✓ **FREN 150/6.0** (*or FREN 100/6.0 or FREN 110/6.0 or FREN 101/3.0 + FREN 102/3.0*)
- ✓ **FREN 231/3.0** (*or FREN 330/3.0 or FREN 344/3.0*)
- ✓ **3.0 units from the Communication and Culture series** of courses at the level of FREN 118 or above

All courses taken for the certificate must be at a level equal to or above FREN 150 (with the exception of FREN 118), **AND** be in good standing.

No more than 6 transferred units can be counted towards the Intermediate level certificate.
