All courses taken for the certificate must be at a level equal to or above FREN 150, **AND** be in good standing. Only 6.0 units from Communication & Culture series (FREN 219, FREN 320) can be counted towards the certificate. No more than 9 transferred units can be counted towards the intermediate-advanced level certificate.
