**INTERMEDIATE-ADVANCED LEVEL**

**Students who are NOT registered in a French Studies Plan** but have taken certain French courses at Queen's, or received equivalent transfer credit, are eligible for a Certificate of Competence in French Language.

NOTE: this is not a Senate-approved Certificate Program and therefore **will be noted as an Academic Milestone on the transcript.**

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- ✓ **24.0 UNITS in French Studies** including required courses:
  - ✓ **FREN 150/6.0** (*or* FREN 100/6.0 *or* FREN 110/6.0 *or* FREN 101/3.0 + FREN 102/3.0)
  - ✓ **FREN 231/3.0** (*or* FREN 201/3.0 *or* FREN 202/3.0 *or* FREN 330/3.0)
  - ✓ **FREN 360/3.0** (*or* FREN 250/3.0 *or* FREN 344/3.0)
  
- ✓ **3.0 units from the Communication & Culture series** of courses at the level of FREN 219 or above

All courses taken for the certificate must be at a level equal to or above FREN 150, **AND** be in good standing. Only 6.0 units from Communication & Culture series (FREN 219, FREN 320) can be counted towards the certificate. No more than 9 transferred units can be counted towards the intermediate-advanced level certificate.
