Congratulations to Dr. Cohen, whose project 'Engine of Inequality? Central Banks, Economic Crisis, and Uneven Development' has been awarded an SSHRC Insight Grant for the 2022 competition year.

Dan's project brings together geographers and accountants at Queen's, York, and Waterloo universities to examine the impact of the **Bank of Canada's** (BOC) unprecedented **Quantitative Easing** (QE) program on spatialized inequality. In response to the COVID-19 crisis, in one year the BOC increased the value of its balance sheet by 370% (from \$122 billion to \$576 billion). Yet despite this scale of purchasing, BOC Governor Tiff Macklem has, somewhat disquietingly, stated we need to "more fully understand [QE's] impact on both income and wealth inequality." This project will 'follow the money' in order to track this impact on inequality, charting who benefited and who was left behind by the BOC's influx of capital into the Canadian economy.
