This committee advises the NCC and federal government on long-range plans for public lands in Canada’s Capital Region; design proposals affecting federal lands and real property matters.

Congratulations to Professor David Gordon (PI) who the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council has awarded \$68,700 in its triennial Aid to Scholarly Journals competition. The grant will support [Canadian Planning and Policy](#), the refereed journal of the [Canadian Institute of Planners](#) and [Association of Canadian University Planning Programs](#).
