

Graduate Student Research Travel Award

Department of History, Queen's University

During the academic year 2022-23, the Department of History will administer a one-time Graduate Student Research Travel Award to help reduce the costs associated with traveling to conduct research for doctoral candidates.

Students will receive the funding as a one-time lumpsum payment. Students will be required to provide receipts to verify how the funding was used in support of their research.

Eligibility:

- Full-time History PhD students in Years 1-5
- Completed Fields Requirements and in good academic standing
- Applicants should have previously received the SGS Graduate Dean's Travel Grant for Doctoral Field Research
- Exceptions to the above eligibility requirements will be made for students who demonstrate the need for immediate, time-sensitive research travel.

Deadline(s): Funding requests for the 2022-23 academic year are due on December 1, 2022.

Award Value: \$1,500 CDN

Successful applicants must fill out the attached receipt submission form and submit it, along with travel receipts, to the Graduate Office by April 30, 2024.
