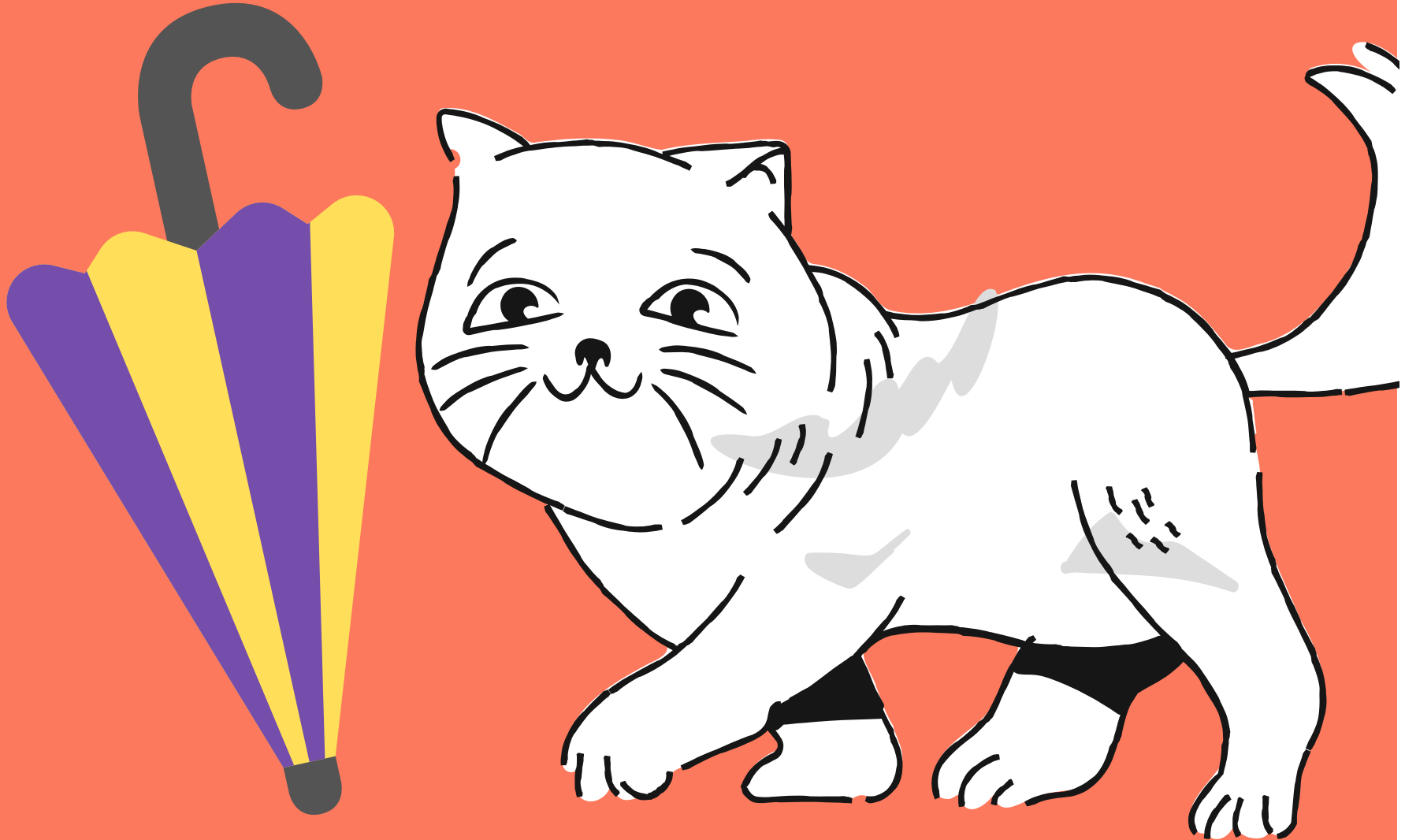
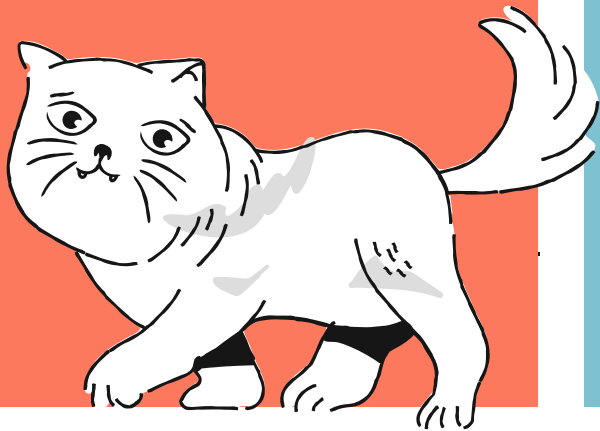

Bulgaria.**

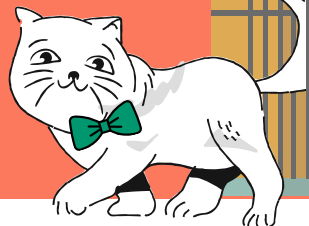
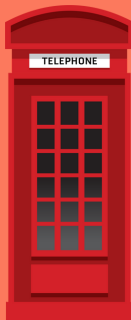

All of a sudden, Georgi felt pain in his right leg.

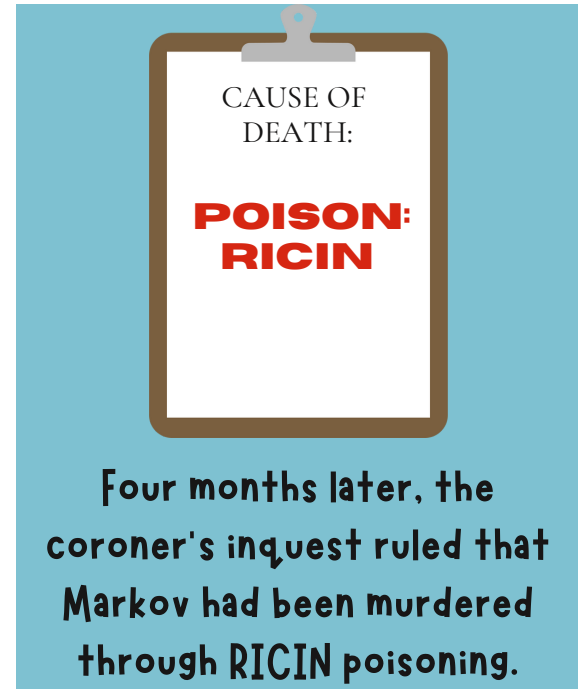
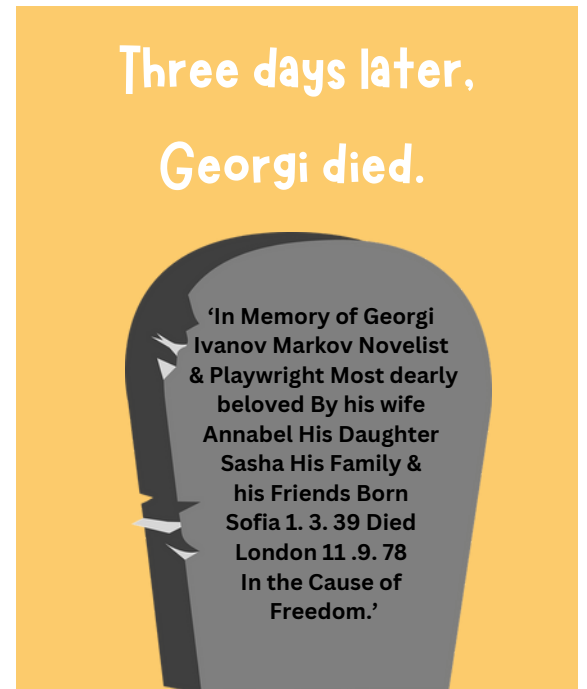
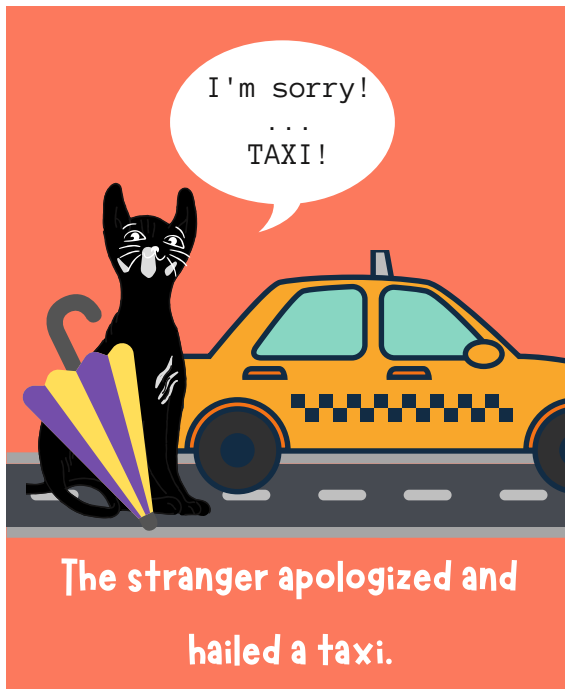


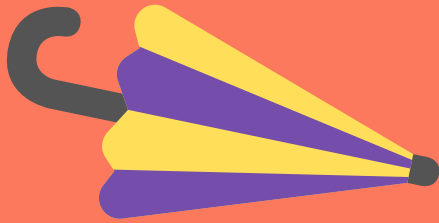
Georgi turned around and saw a stranger picking up his umbrella.

It was concluded that a RICIN bullet was implanted into Georgi's right thigh through the tip of a specially modified umbrella.

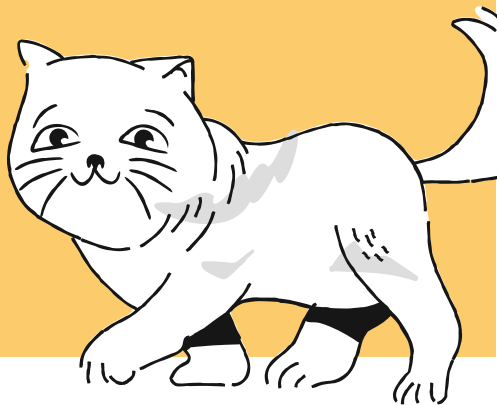
WHAT IS RICIN?
