June 20th - Course list & Timetable published on SOLUS

July 4-8 - Advanced Course Selection for 3rd and 4th year HIST Majors and Medials

July 11 - Students can view their enrolment appointments and begin loading their SOLUS shopping cart

July 18-25 - Course Registration

July 26 - Registration Pause Day (no enrolments)

July 27 - Enrolment Restrictions Lifted

August 1 - 14 - Registration Hiatus

August 15 - Open Enrolment Begins (up to 18 units per term)
