# ADVANCED COURSE SELECTION

All third and fourth-year History Major and Medial students are invited to participate in History's advanced course selection period which runs from July 26th to 30th.

During advanced course selection, upper-level History students are guaranteed early enrolment in two upper-level seminars for the 2021-2022 academic year. You will enroll yourself in the rest of your Fall and Winter courses during the regular enrollment period in August.

We will provide you with an advanced course selection form where you will indicate your top four choices for your upper-level seminars in Fall 2021 and Winter 2022. You will only be enrolled in two of the four seminars that you request, and we will do our best to accommodate your top choices.

## CORE SEMINARS

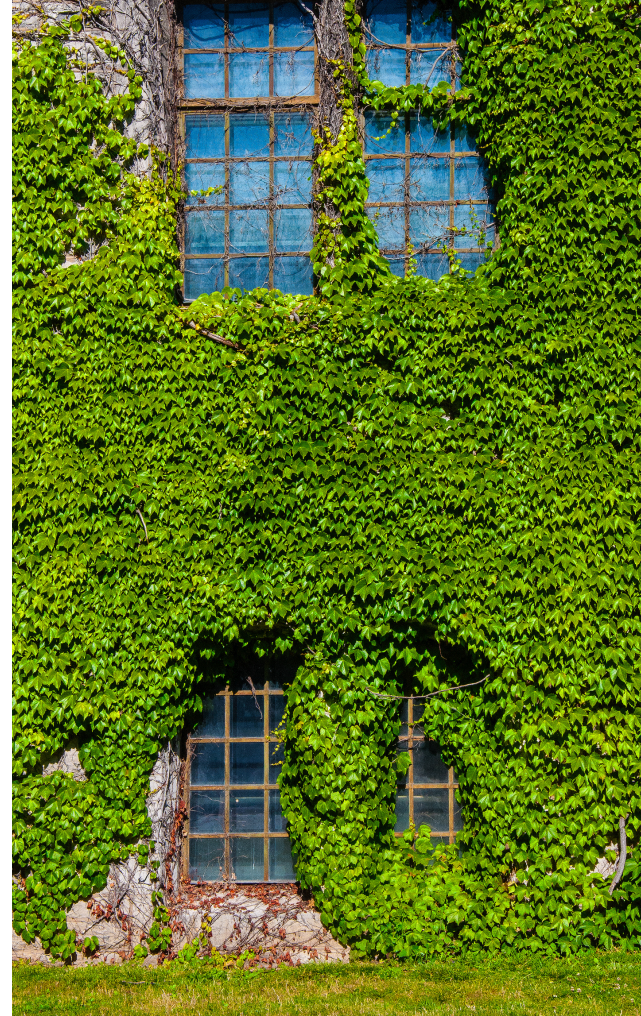
### ATTENTION ALL SECOND-YEAR HISTORY MAJORS AND MEDIALS
