

## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR CSB/SCB 2010

### INTRODUCTION

This document contains instructions about the abstract submission process. Abstracts for the CSB/SCB 2010 conference must be submitted electronically via the conference website, by 15 February 2010. Abstracts may be submitted as PDF.

### METHODS

The abstract is limited to one 8.5 x 11 cm page with two columns of text, justified. Top and bottom margins should be 20 mm while right and left margins should be 15 mm. Type font is Times New Roman or Times Roman 10pt. This document should be used as a template to format your abstract.

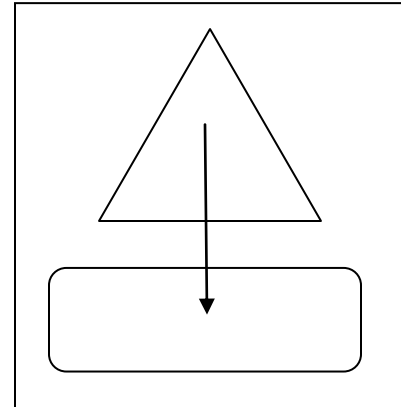
Title should be in bold capital letters. Title, author names and affiliations should be centered across the page [1]. Superscripts following the author names should be used to refer to authors' affiliations. An email address of the corresponding author should be included. A web address of department, laboratory or author may be included if desired.

The abstract should be divided into the following sections: Introduction, Methods, Results, and Discussion/Conclusion. Text should be right and left justified without paragraph indentation. In the abstract, when referring to equipment or software etc. please include the device in the following format: "The measurements were taken with a Widget™ Device (Widgets Inc., State/Province, Country)"[2].

### RESULTS

Within the document, figures and tables should be referred to in the text (Figure 1). Figures and Tables should be placed close to the text. If the figures or tables are wider than one column, they may be placed below the last section containing text and across the page (Table 1).

References should be formatted as illustrated on this page and citations within the text should be made with numbers in square brackets [1,2].

### DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSIONS

In order to be considered for an award, you must check off the box for that award during the online submission process and all requirements must be fulfilled (these will be noted on the abstract submission page). Please note, each abstract can be nominated for one award only. In the event an incomplete submission is received, it will be withheld from acceptance until the authors supply all required components.
