- Develop content for website and promotional activities, especially by going to Jewish Studies classes, interviewing students and professors there, and photographing them.
- Attend student orientations, open houses, majors night, and other similar events to promote the program.
- Other duties as required.

You will be reporting to the Director of Jewish Studies and the Administrative and Program Assistant.

- Student must be entering into full time studies for the 2022-2023 academic year, preferably with a Jewish Studies minor or interest in our courses.
