

**COVID-19 Self Assessment Questionnaire**  
**Department of Mathematics and Statistics**

- Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms or signs (Symptoms should not be chronic or related to other known causes or conditions)
  - Fever or chills
  - Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
  - Cough
  - Sore throat, trouble swallowing
  - Runny/stuffy nose or nasal congestion
  - Decrease or loss of smell or taste
  - Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
  - Not feeling well, extreme tiredness, sore muscles
- Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?
- Have you had close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
- In the past 14 days, have you been in close contact with someone who is currently sick with symptoms associated with COVID-19 and NOT undergoing active testing for COVID-19?
- Are you under a public health order/recommendation to limit contact/self-isolate/quarantine due to the risk of COVID-19?

If you answered 'yes' to any of the above questions, it is recommended that you go home and self-isolate and:
