Biography:

Peter Loewen is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Science at the University of Toronto, Mississauga. He is also an Assistant Editor of the Canadian Journal of Political Science, a collaborator on the Canadian Election Study, and Director of the Centre for the Study of the United States (CSUS) at the Munk School. Peter's research interests include Canadian politics, elections, political behaviour, genopolitics, behavioural economics and experimentation. His work has appeared in many prominent journals, including the American Journal of Political Science, Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences, the Journal of Politics, Electoral Studies, Political Psychology, Party Politics, and others.
