Ceren Belge is an Assistant Professor of Political Science at Concordia University. She received her Ph.D. at the University of Washington. She held a postdoctoral fellowship at the Harvard Academy for International and Area Studies before coming to Concordia. Her research interests include nationalism and ethnic conflict, the politics of law, and gender. Her dissertation on honor killings and state-minority relations in Turkey and Israel received the best dissertation awards of the Law and Society Association and Israel Studies Association. Her articles have been published in the *International Journal of Middle East Studies*, *Law and Society Review*, and *Israel Studies Forum*.
