

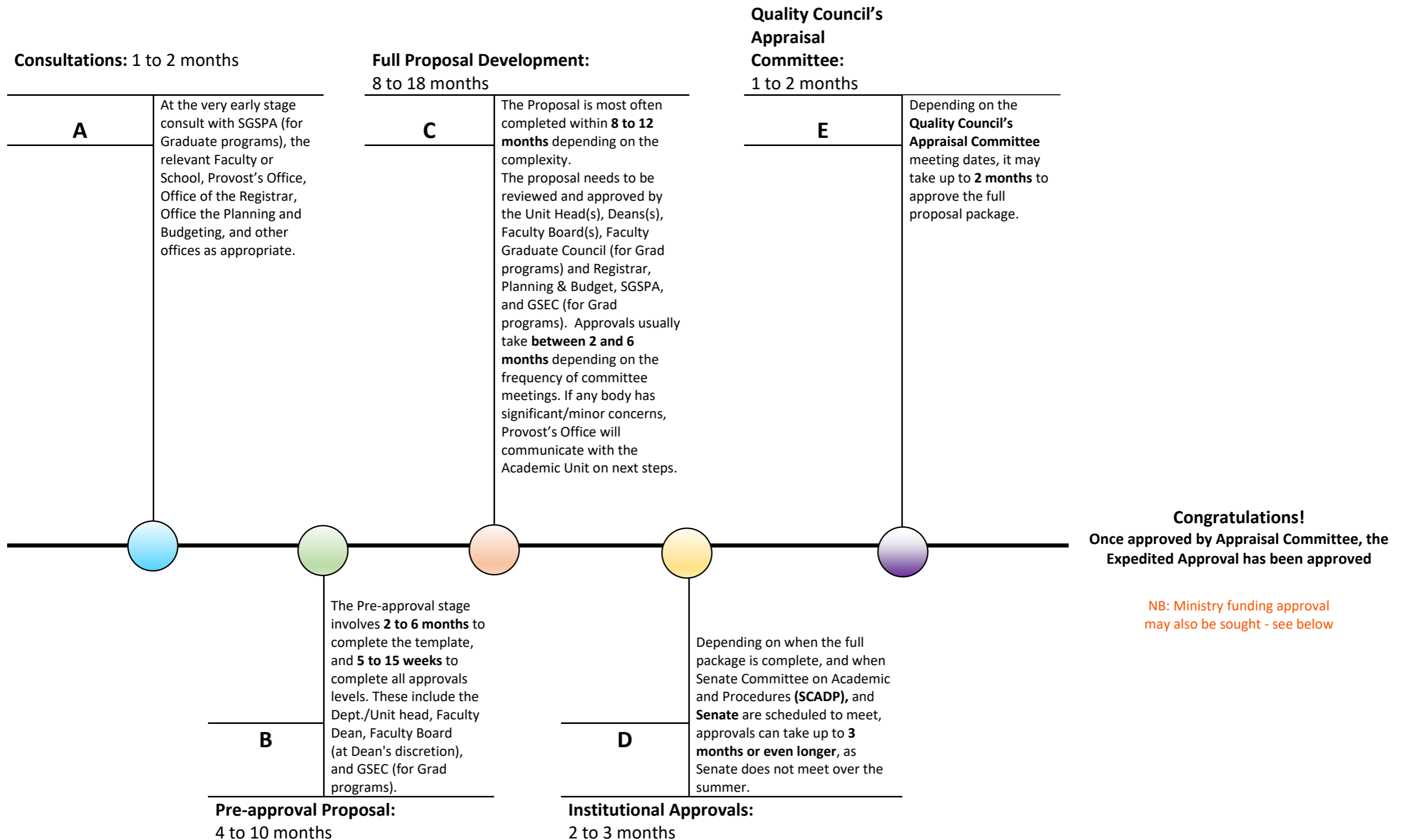
## Timeline for Expedited Approvals

### (Quality Council's Appraisal Committee is the final level of approval)

(The total estimated time it takes to complete an Expedited Approval is between **16 and 35 months!**)

This Protocol applies to the following proposal types:

- New for-credit graduate diploma (Types 2 and 3);
- New standalone degree programs arising from a long-standing field in a master's or doctoral program that has undergone at least two Cyclical Program Reviews and has at least two graduating cohorts



**Note:**

- Once approved by Senate, the Provost's Office will submit the funding application for a funding eligible program to the Ministry of College and Universities (MCU). Ministry funding approval can take from 4 months to over a year.
- The Program can commence before the MCU approval for funding is received, but the Faculty offering the program assumes the financial risk of offering the program before funding is approved.
- Next steps may include subsequent reporting or continues improvement requirements, and a 5-year follow-up report. These reporting requirements will be tracked by the Provost's Office.
