	Verifiability: Micro-credentials will be verifiable, and integrity will be maintained. Ownership: Once awarded, micro-credentials and associated data will be the property of the earner. (Note we understand the "property" to be the products of their own learning). Issuing Body: Micro-credentials will be issued by an established agency, organization, institution, or employer.
	Assessment: Micro-credentials will require evidence of achievement of outcomes.
	Outcomes: Micro-credentials will recognize performance competencies explicitly aligned to underlying knowledge, attitudes, and skills.
Proposals <u>could</u> include:	
	Partner endorsement: Micro-credentials will be validated by industry partners/external bodies, where possible.
	Certification: Upon successful completion, learners will be awarded certification endorsed by the university that verifies their acquisition of the stated outcomes. Relevance: Micro-credentials will often be issued for competencies that are currently relevant to the labour market. Relevance is often achieved through consultation and partnership between employers and post-secondary institutions.
