

# QSSET for Students

## Setting up QSSET

1. Receive email Monday morning, during one of the final weeks of the course. Normally the second-to-last week but can be adjusted for system load balancing or by instructor request.
2. Click link on email and complete survey. Surveys remain open from Monday morning until Friday 5pm of the same week and can be completed using any device with a web browser. The survey has been optimized for mobile, tablet and desktop screen sizes. There is no log-in required to access the survey. Here is an example email invitation to answer a QSSET survey, followed by screenshots of the QSSET survey questions:
