Website Redesign

- Big changes will be happening this summer

 - Funding (this has been updated recently – still somewhat inaccurate, will likely be fact checked by a student)
 - TA/RAships, research fellowships
 - Necessary for incoming students
 - Harassment resources/statement
 - Area manuals with timelines
 - Clinical area is working on this
 - Nothing for CogNeuro
 - Dev & Social need updates
 - Resources for faculty
 - Guide for developing lab manual (standard template)
 - Authorship guide
 - Platform for student dialogue/collaboration
 - Meeting minutes/AGSIP content
- Need content reviews for ongoing relevance
 - Faculty responsibility or compensated work for students
 - Communicate when pages have been updated
 - Include date updated at the bottom of each page
