


# My Visit to Queen's


You and your parents are coming to Queen's soon. Queen's is a university which is a school for big kids. You will meet some nice people who learn about how kids grow up.

When you come to Queen's a nice person will meet you and your parents and show them where to park their car.




The nice person will show you where our center is. You and your parents will walk down these stairs and go in these doors. Our center is through the doors on the left hand side.
