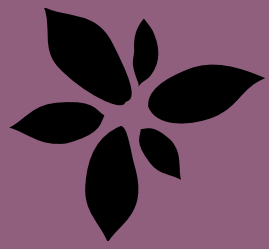


EMPOWERING OTHERS
